## **President's Message**



Dear Supporters,

I'm pleased to report that in 2024 HumaneCNY successfully placed more dogs and cats into loving homes than in any other year of its operation. In fact, over the past 12 years, HumaneCNY has gone from adopting 120 animals a year to nearly 800! This dramatic increase is a direct result of operational changes

made possible by the continued backing of our supporters. We recognize and appreciate the faith you've placed in us to rescue as many homeless cats and dogs as possible while providing for each animal's physical, emotional, and behavioral health.

Here are just a few ways we are doing this:

**Enhanced Foster Program –** HumaneCNY's community of foster homes continues to grow. Currently, we have 33

animals-- 20 dogs and 13 cats—enjoying the comforts of living in a home. This represents 32% of the animals currently in our care! With Kitten Season just around the corner, we're extremely grateful to have this network of compassionate caregivers willing to offer their homes to animals in need.

**Shorter Lengths of Stay** – Most dogs and cats leave HumaneCNY within 30 days of their arrivals! As soon as an animal arrives, our staff leaps into action. If there's a health

concern, the animal receives immediate veterinary care. All animals are vaccinated and spayed/neutered as quickly as possible. During daily rounds, staff monitor and respond quickly to each animal's condition. Additionally, our staff promotes a positive adoption experience that encourages adopters to thoughtfully accept the responsibility of caring for their new pet for the rest of its life.

Daily Enrichment – Mental health is just as important as physical health. Therefore, HumaneCNY is committed to the emotional wellbeing of all its animals. Staff and volunteers use many techniques to reduce stress, read body language, and conduct behavior assessments. All of this results in happier dogs and cats, comfortable with showing their loving personalities to potential adopters who just can't resist taking them home!

Rescuing and rehoming hundreds of dogs and cats each year is extremely rewarding! We remain

# **Happy Tails**

Although most of our dogs and cats find new homes within a few months, these **Happy Tails** are examples that HumaneCNY understands that some animals need a bit more time than others to achieve their **Happy Ever After!** 

- Jesse was at the shelter for 620 days before he found his forever home. He arrived at the shelter with a fractured pelvis and a broken tail, which needed to be amputated. Despite some behavioral issues that required ongoing training and patience, he found his people who are willing to put in the work in return for lots of love. Now he's happy at home with feline brother, Romeo, who's also a HumaneCNY alumni!
- **Teddy** spent more than 8 months in the shelter, watching as many cats around him found their happy homes. Finally, in December his new family came along and gave him a chance. Teddy settled in nicely and enjoyed his first ever holiday season at home!
- **Mister** is a sweet and shy little guy who came from an overcrowded home where he received minimal human attention. Because he was a little wary of human interaction, he spent over 100 days at the shelter being loved on by staff and volunteers before finding his forever home.
- **Sally** is a sweet young Pit mix who spent nearly 10 months at the shelter before she found her family. At first, they were just fostering Sally, but they quickly realized they couldn't imagine life without her in it! Her new family has sent us photos of Sally relaxing on their boat, enjoying a toy in the yard, and taking naps on her cozy bed.

- Max was an emaciated senior dog whose story made national news after he was found tied to a park bench with a note pleading, "I'm a good boy... please help me!". Max spent 5 months with a loving foster who learned about him and his senior ways. With the help of his foster, we found the perfect retirement home for Max a family that understands that all Max needs is patience, lots of treats, and even more love!
- **Diamond** was with us for over 600 days after being severely neglected during her puppyhood. But thankfully, she found her people just in time for the holidays, and they report that she was made for them. They love her dearly!
